6.3 Quality improvement strategies adopted by the institution for each of the following:

6.3.1 Curriculum Development

- Teachers are members of different subject teacher's association at University level where they discuss the syllabus and contribute in the curriculum development.
- Teaching and Learning:- Teachers enrich and update their knowledge by attending Orientation Course, Refresher Course and etc.
- Teachers prepare teaching plan and teach accordingly. They also take extra classes.

6.3.2 Teaching and Learning

- Our staff members adopt modern methods like PPT, using models and smart boards in teaching, in addition to traditional way of teaching.
- The college arranges seminars, guest lectures, study tours, Remedial classes, bridge courses etc.

6.3.3 Examination and Evaluation

- Students are provided with old question papers, question paper solving session and model practical exams are conducted.
- The College has an examination committee which conducts periodical tests. The assessed answer scripts are returned to the students. Suggestions are given for improvement. This helps the students to improve their quality.

6.3.4 Research and Development

- Teachers are encouraged to attend seminars, conferences and present paper. They are also encouraged to guide students for the M.Phil, Ph.D. degrees.
- The College has a research committee which encourages the staff to write MRPs and to take up research work. Members of the staff are also encouraged to go on FIP.

6.3.5 Library, ICT and physical infrastructure / instrumentation

- Inlibnet facility, educational CD's, soft copy of old question papers are made available.
- The College enriches the library by adding new volumes on various subjects and subscribes to many journals with the help of funds from Management and UGC
- Physical infrastructure of the College is continuously improved based on the need.
- New instruments are purchased as per the needs by using the fund from UGC and Management.
- The existing instruments are maintained in proper order by getting them repaired whenever required.
